

16 Commercial burglaries


- 8 with known suspect/arrest

- 2 tied to one suspect along with a MVT




UPDATE: MVT & RECOVERIES

- 10 vehicles stolen outside of city recovered by Boulder








UPDATE: CATALYTIC CONVERTER THEFTS


12 Catalytic converters stolen:

 - Thefts from 09/30-10/12
 - All stolen from Ford Econoline vans
 - 4th catalytic converter stolen 8/28-8/29 at Millennium from Econoline van
- 25% were stolen from Toyota Priuses
- 17% were stolen from Jeeps







Sexual Assault Reports by Occurred Month








August Crime Spree Suspect



- Victim -77 y/o male 29th Street Mall
- Suspect had been in the area and positively identified by officers.


Multiple Contacts and Arrests:

- 08/17/2022, Arrested for MVT PR Bond
- 08/19/2022, Summoned for Trespassing, Littering, and Camping
- 08/20/2022, Arrested for Trespassing, Obstruction, and misdemeanor Theft PR Bond
- 08/21/2022, Seen swinging a baseball bat at multiple children at North Boulder Park. No victim identified
- 08/25/2022, Arrested for Attempted MVT & Felony Theft and Criminal Mischief PR Bond
- 08/26 2022, Arrested Theft –At Risk

DA Motion filed- court revoked PR bonds \$30K secured bond



Arrest of Serial Offender: Burglary and Indecent Exposure



- In September BPD began an investigation into a serial burglary suspect who was entering the un-secure apartments of college-aged women and committing lewd sexual acts
- Patrol Officers and Detectives quickly identified a suspect and within 24 hours were able to take him into custody
- A search warrant was executed at his home and multiple items of evidence were located
- The suspect was on probation for prior indecent exposure cases and had recently been taken off GPS ankle monitoring
- Suspect was charged with multiple felonies and in November was sentenced to 2 years in the Department of Youth Corrections and will be required to register as a sex offender upon release



Arrest of Serial Burglar



- In September, BPD identified a serial burglar that was very active throughout the city.
- Suspect would primarily check unlocked doors, especially in apartment complexes and condos.
- If suspect entered an occupied apartment he would make up a story that he accidentally entered the wrong unit
- Suspect stole cash, small items, electronics, jewelry, shoes
- Detectives identified the suspect and authored an arrest warrant. He was taken into custody shortly thereafter.
- Tied to at least 18 burglaries in Boulder, and known to other law enforcement agencies in northern Colorado



Drug Distribution and Bicycle Chop Shop



Operation in September and October 2022

- Long-Term Investigation commenced with assistance from The Boulder County Drug Task Force
- Warrant obtained and significant items found at property:
 - Thousands of dollars in cash
 - 13 bikes, several of which were reported stolen
 - Multiple bike parts
 - Firearms
 - Methamphetamine
 - Over 100 fentanyl pills
- Multiple arrests occurred for numerous felony charges
- Actively working with the property management company and BHP



Hill Shooting and Officer Involved Shooting



- October 2, 2022, around 1:30 am: 5 males in two groups arguing, physically fighting in area of the Sink at 13th and Pennsylvania Ave
- Multiple suspects fired shots at bystanders and in the direction of officers
- Multiple suspects have since been arrested and charged with attempted first-degree murder and other charges
- Community members cooperation directly contributed to the arrest and investigation of this case



Shots Fired-Reckless Discharge



- October 3rd, Officers called downtown for shots heard at multiple locations
- Witnesses observed 2 males walking from Lawry Lane WB towards 11th Firing shots in the air
- Separate witnesses observe male fire shots from a vehicle into the air at 7th & Walnut
- Officers found multiple shell casings at each location
- Officers locate the suspect vehicle and conduct a high-risk traffic stop
- 2 Suspects were taken into custody and a firearm was located
- The shooter was arrested and taken to jail for 3 charges of prohibited use of weapons, careless driving, reckless driving, reckless endangerment, and disorderly conduct



Shots Fired-Attempted Shooting



- November 7th Officers were dispatched to 993 E.
 Moorehead on a male actively firing a gun
- Nearby citizens tackled him, keeping him held down until police arrived
- Officers determined that the suspect lived nearby.
 Evidence of shots fired was located inside the home
- A witness/victim was contacted and indicated that the suspect tried to shoot him in the apartment the prior night and a bullet just missed his head and lodged in a wall
- Detectives authored a search warrant and a gun and additional evidence was located inside the home
- The suspect was charged with multiple felonies, including possession of a firearm by a previous felon
