INTRODUCTION

The City of Boulder Open Space Department (BOSD) has undertaken a year-long survey of public visitation on Open Space Lands. The BOSD visitation study was initiated to meet three objectives:

- To estimate the total number of visitors to the Open Space System between June 1, 1992, and May 31, 1993;
- To describe activity choices, length of stay, party-size and composition, and place-of-residence of Open Space visitors; and
- To test a predictive model using indirect measures. (For more information see the Visitation Study Plan.)

PROBLEM STATEMENT

The BOSD Visitation Study does not attempt to quantify the tremendous amount of information provided by the public in the form of written comments. The Visitor Comment Study was established to capture this information in the form of a usable, interactive database. The unprompted and non-structured comments are made on the back of the survey cards in the limited space provided. While the comments do provide very valuable information, it must be realized that they represent only the persons using the Open Space System choosing to volunteer their comments. Therefore, comments do not represent a sample of all visitors to the Open Space System. It is important to remember this fact when evaluating the findings from this study.

STUDY OBJECTIVE

The objective of the Visitor Comment Study is to record and analyze public comments made between June 1, 1992, and May 31, 1993, in conjunction with the BOSD Visitation Study. Analyzed information will provide Open Space Managers with an effective tool to further enhance their understanding of the public's opinion regarding certain Open Space issues and the complexities of particular neighborhoods. This information may also assist in identifying existing conflicts among recreationalists or between the multiple uses that occur on Open Space. In a limited sense, it provides information about customer service issues as well.

METHODOLOGY

Quantifying comments poses a complex task. In order to create a database in which information can be easily and accurately extracted, all comments must first be coded. Coding comments can be subjective and the original meaning of a comment could be lost. In an effort to create the most accurate database, four individuals were responsible for coding all of the comments. In order to ensure the exact meaning of each comment was preserved, the entire comment was also entered into the database. Microsoft Excel 4.0 software was chosen for the study because it has a larger character capacity than other software. This allows for the whole or most of the comment to be entered. This method creates a usable, consistent database and gives the Open Space Managers the option of reading the public's comments in their entirety. It also provides the possibility of responding if a name, address or phone number was offered.

Comments were coded based on the following criteria:

DATE--ZONE--BOX--PROPERTY NAME--PROPERTY NUMBER--TYPE--ISSUE--SPECIFIC.

Date, zone, and box were used to indicate the date and location of each comment

(see Appendix 1, City of Boulder Open Space System and ten sample zones). Property name and property number further indicate location of comments and provide compatible information for the G.I.S. lab applications and property database. TYPE, ISSUE, and SPECIFIC were used to define the comment's content (see Appendix 2, Definitions for Comment Database). TYPE refers to the overall theme of a comment. ISSUE refers to the particular issue within the comment type. SPECIFIC describes the respondents feelings about the type of comment and issue they have mentioned. If a comment had more than one major theme, it was entered into the database more than once. Below are some actual examples from the database.

EXAMPLE ONE:

"I am disturbed at the parking restrictions recently imposed on the streets such as Cragmoor. This has the effect of limiting access to these City-maintained trails to only those who can afford to live near the park. Parking should be allowed on public streets everywhere."

DATA ANALYSIS

There are a number of different ways to manipulate the data depending on what type of information is desired. Comments may be tabulated according to the entire Open Space System or by zones. Tabulating data according to the entire Open Space System is useful in obtaining an overview of certain comment TYPES and

ISSUES. Stratifying comments according to zones provides profiles highlighting what types of comments were made at different zones and helps identify the overall concerns and issues that were common for a particular geographic area.

Comments may also be stratified according to box site or property name giving a much more site specific view of where certain comment TYPES and ISSUES are prevalent. Analyzing the SPECIFIC category seems to be the most useful way to manipulate the database, because it isolates a category of comment TYPES, which then can be stratified by zone or by box site. This type of analysis shows what the public's comments were pertaining to specific issues and locates their occurrence within the Open Space System.

ANALYSIS EXAMPLE

In these examples, all of the dog comments that have been entered into the database to date are analyzed. All of the dog comments are extracted from the main database and included in Appendix 3 for review. Cross-tabulating the database provides all of the information necessary for an in-depth analysis of comments made by the public concerning dogs on Open Space.


In the first example, an overview of the total dog comments made concerning Open Space are illustrated in a cross-tabulation table (See Table 1, p. 6). This information is further illustrated in graph form for visual reference (Refer to Graph 1, p. 7). Specific issues are also isolated for comparison. In this example, Amenity, Cleanup, and Feces comments are presented in a graph to illustrate their relationship (Refer to Graph 2, p. 8).


The second example looks at total dog comments for a particular Open Space area, Zone 5 Sanitas. The cross-tabulation table shows the total dog comments made in this area, and what each comment was concerning (See Table 2, p. 9). This information is further illustrated in a graph (Refer to Graph 3, p. 10). Access, Off-Leash, and Voice Control issues are isolated for comparison purposes (Refer to Graph 4, p. 11).

CROSSTABULATION FOR ALL DOG COMMENTS







AMENITY, CLEAN-UP, AND FECES DOG COMMENTS





SUMMARY



AGRICULTURE

POLICY: Includes comments concerning the use of Open

Space for farming practices.

AMENITY

GARBAGE CAN: Includes comments concerning the need for garbage can(s) at a particular location; excluding those requested for dog clean-up.

GENERAL: Includes comments dealing with more than two amenities mentioned in one comment, or an amenity that is not listed under the amenity type; also overall improvements to a trail or trailhead.

INTERPRETATION: includes comments concerning the quality of the interp boards or requesting additional interp boards and/or other interp tools (such as flower i.d. signs).

MAP: Includes the quality (map distances, location of trails, or inaccuracies) and need for at a specific/general location.

PARKING LOT: Includes comments concerning the maintenance of or need for a new or recently established parking lot at a specific/general location ("We didn't need such a big

- parking lot along Lee Hill Rd.").
- PICNIC FACILITY: Includes any comment requesting additional picnic facilities, maintenance of existing picnic facility, or regulations at a picnic facility.
- PUBLICATION: Includes comments requesting additional information or brochures about wildlife, vegetation, cultural resources, or other aspects of the Open Space system, excluding maps or information posted on interp boards.
- RESTROOM: Includes comments concerning the quality or maintenance of existing restroom facilities, or the request for additional restroom facilities at a specific location.
- WATER: Includes comments requesting water fountains or stations for users or pets at a specific/general location.

BIKE

- ACCESS: Includes comments requesting opening of existing trails to bikes; also those comments wanting, not wanting, or wanting to limit bike access; or those expressing general satisfaction or dissatisfaction with a specific/general trail example: "I like biking on this trail".
- DAMAGE: Includes comments dealing with damage of trail or nontrail areas by bikes (esp. during wet times).
- EDUCATION: Includes comments expressing need for mandatory or non-mandatory safety, etiquette, or erosion control instruction for bicyclists.
- ENFORCEMENT: Includes comments concerning need for posting of regulations or ranger patrol for bicycle speed or access violations.
- ETIQUETTE: Includes comments concerning the lack of courtesy or etiquette of bicyclists.
- SAFETY: Includes comments specifically dealing with incidents

between bicyclists and other trail users.

TRAIL: Includes comments expressing need for new bicycle trails on Open Space.

CATTLE

AESTHETICS: Includes comments concerning the visual appearance of cattle on Open Space.

FECES: Includes comments dealing with the need for clean-up of cow feces or the quantity of feces on Open Space.

POLICY: Includes comments specifically referring to the use of Open Space for cattle grazing; also comments dealing with overgrazing of Open Space.

CITY PARK

LOCUST: Any comment concerning the development of a city park in the Locust Street area.

CLIMBING

ACCESS: Includes comments expressing the need for continued access of Open Space or additional access by climbers.

AESTHETICS: Includes comments concerning the allowance and appearance of bolting, chalk, etc.

DOG

ACCESS: Includes comments concerning allowance of dogs onto general or specific properties; also includes comments concerning satisfaction or dissatisfaction with a specific/general area ("I like this area for exercising my pet.").

AMENITY: Includes comments referring to dog pickup stations, bags, garbage cans and other supplies for dog clean-up.

BEHAVIOR: Includes comments concerning courtesy and conduct of dogs using OS.

CLEAN-UP: Includes comments concerning clean-up of dog

feces along Open Space trails (specific or general).

ENFORCEMENT: Includes comments requesting leash, voicecontrol, access, or clean-up enforcement by Open Space rangers; also the posting of regulations.

FECES: Includes comments concerning the amount and aesthetics of dog feces at trailheads and along specific/general trails.

OFF-LEASH: Includes comments concerning off-leash regulations; also expressing satisfaction or dissatisfaction with off-leash regulations ("Great place for dogs to run free.").

VOICE CONTROL: Includes comments specifically dealing with policies and regulations concerning voice control of dogs.

WILDLIFE: Includes comments describing dog interactions with wildlife.

FISHING

ACCESS: Includes comments regarding access to fishing on Open Space properties.

REGULATION: Includes any comments regarding Open Space fishing regulations.

GENERAL O.S.

ACCESS: Includes comments concerning general access to

Open Space; excluding comments stating a specific activity.

ACQUISITION: Includes comments mentioning acquisition of specific/general Open Space properties.

AESTHETICS: Includes comments referring to the general aesthetics of Open Space, such as: beauty, nice, lovely, fun, wonderful and enjoyment; also comments referring to enjoyment of a specific area, example: "great area", etc.

CHANGE: Includes any comment referring to altering or changing

Open Space's present state or current policies; examples -
"Leave it the way it is", "No development", "Leave it

- natural", "Don't sell", "Maintain", "Protect", etc.
- CONCEPT: Includes any comment concerning the general Open Space system as a whole; examples: "I like O.S."; like idea, system; good job, etc; includes quality of life; also "I like having Open Space near my home or within walking distance.".
- OIL AND GAS: Includes any comment concerning oil and gas development or extraction on Open Space.
- REGULATION: Includes comments dealing with the general regulations of the Open Space system as a whole.
- TAX: Includes comments concerning the use of tax money by Open Space.
- THANKS: Comments that mention "Thank you" alone or as the main idea.
- USAGE: Includes comments referring to the overall amount of usage of Open Space by users.
- VOLUNTEER: Any comment concerning a user wanting to volunteer for Open Space.
- WELL BEING: Includes comments in which users state a spiritual, psychological benefit from using Open Space.

HIKER

- DAMAGE: Includes comments dealing with damage of trail or nontrail areas by hikers (esp. during wet times).
- EDUCATION: Includes comments expressing need for mandatory or non-mandatory etiquette or erosion control instruction for

hikers.

ETIQUETTE: Includes comments concerning the lack of courtesy or etiquette of hikers using Open Space.

HORSE

ACCESS: Includes comments concerning allowance of

horses onto general or specific properties; also expressing satisfaction or dissatisfaction with a specific/general area, example -- "I like to ride my horse in this area.").

CLEAN-UP: Includes comments concerning clean-up of horse feces along Open Space trails (general or specific).

DAMAGE: Includes comments concerning damage related to horse use to trails or non-trail areas (esp. during wet times).

etiquette. Includes comments expressing a need for mandatory or non-mandatory instruction about erosion control or etiquette.

ETIQUETTE: Includes comments dealing with the etiquette of horseback riders on general/specific Open Space trails.

FECES: Includes comments expressing concerns over the amount and aesthetics of horse feces at trailheads and along specific/general trails.

MOUNTAIN PARK

GENERAL: Includes comments discussing any aspect of the Mountain Parks system.

NON-BOULDER
USE

FEE: Includes comments regarding charging a fee for non-boulder use of Open Space.

OPINION: Any comment dealing with the use of Open Space by non-Boulder residents.

PRAIRIE DOG

AESTHETICS: Includes comments concerning the presence and impacts of prairie dogs on Open Space (Wildlife vs. pest).

MANAGEMENT: Includes comments concerning Open Space prairie dog management policies and methods, including extermination.

RANGER

ENFORCEMENT: Includes comments concerning Open Space ranger enforcement of regulations, excluding dog or bike enforcement.

PATROL: Includes comments referring to the presence of rangers on Open Space; also comments referring to ranger contact with the public.

ROLLER BLADE

ACCESS: Includes comments requesting opening of existing or new trails to roller bladers; those comments wanting or not wanting to limit roller blader access.

ETIQUETTE: Includes comments concerning the lack of courtesy or etiquette of roller bladers using general/specific Open Space trails.

RUNNER

DAMAGE: Includes comments dealing with damage of trails or nontrail areas by runners (esp. during wet times).

education: Includes comments indicating the need for mandatory or non-mandatory safety, etiquette, or erosion control instruction for runners.

ETIQUETTE: Includes comments concerning the lack of courtesy or etiquette of runners using general/specific Open Space trails.

SAFETY: Includes comments specifically dealing with incidents between runners and other trail users.

SKIING

REGULATION: Includes any comment concerning skiing regulations of Open Space (general or specific properties).

TRAIL

DESIGN: Includes comments referring to the design of new, recently constructed, or reconstructed specific/general trails

on Open Space.

GENERAL: Includes comments concerning enjoyment of trails for running, hiking, or in general; example: "I like this trail"; also those comments referring to trail system as a whole.

HANDICAP: Includes any comment dealing with any type of handicap issue on Open Space.

JUNIOR RANGER: Includes comments concerning any Junior Ranger activities on Open Space.

LITTER: Includes comments concerning the presence or quantity of litter along general/specific trails or at trailheads.

MAINTENANCE: Includes comments concerning the quality or amount of maintenance of general/specific Open Space trails; also comments dealing with erosion control, fences or gates.

NEW: Includes comments expressing the need for new trails, trail extensions or expansions.

PAVEMENT: Includes comments concerning the aesthetics of or need for pavement on specific/general trails.

SIGN: Includes comments referring to the quality (accuracy), quantity, or need for additional information at certain locations; excluding interp boards and dog/bike enforcement postings.

USE STUDY

COMPLIANCE: Includes comments concerning user compliance to the use study.

PURPOSE: Includes comments referring to the overall purpose of the use study.

VEGETATION

AESTHETICS: Includes comments concerning the quantity and quality of vegetation on Open Space properties, excluding

weeds.

MANAGEMENT: Includes comments suggesting planting of additional vegetation or management of vegetation on specific/general Open Space properties, excluding mowing of vegetation along trails and weed control or policy.

WEED

AMOUNT: Includes comments concerning the abundance of weeds on general/specific Open Space properties.

CONTROL: Includes comments dealing with the control of weeds on general/specific Open Space properties.

POLICY: Includes comments concerning Open Space policy of weed control.

WILDLIFE

AESTHETICS: Includes comments concerning the presence, quantity and quality of wildlife on Open Space, excluding prairie dogs.

MANAGEMENT: Includes comments expressing the need for management of wildlife on Open Space, excluding prairie dogs; also comments concerning Open Space management policies in general, excluding prairie dogs.
